HOW TO RECYCLE

Take a moment to designate a special space in your kitchen or hallway for both your recycle and trash can. Refer to the inside of this brochure for a detailed list on what items can be recycled. Carry your bagged recycle and bagged trash to the community enclosure. Please place recycle in the white bin and trash in the blue bin. Thank you for helping us reduce our waste!

OTHER ITEMS

Items that cannot properly fit in your bin require a special pick up.

BULKY ITEMS

Items that cannot fit in your bins are considered bulky items. Bulky items must be manageable by a two-person crew. Common bulky items include:

- Couches
- Mattresses
- Tables
- Excess Green Waste

WHITE GOODS HOUSEHOLD APPLIANCES

Household appliances containing Freon and other white goods cannot be placed in your bins. Examples include:

- Refrigerators
- Air Conditioners
- Dishwashers
- Water Heaters

E-WASTE

Electronic Waste (e-waste) is anything with a circuit board or battery. It is illegal to dispose of e-waste in any of your bins. Examples include:

- Monitors
- MP3 Players/Stereos
- Microwave Devices
- Computers/Laptops
- Televisions
- VCRs/DVD Players
- Printers/Scanners
- Cell Phones


HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE

Household Hazardous Wastes (HHW) are products that are flammable, corrosive, reactive or toxic. They are dangerous to the public and environment.

It is illegal to dispose of HHW in any of your automated carts. Examples include:

- Auto Fluids
- Pesticides/Herbicides
- Propane
- Pool Chemicals
- Cleaning Products
- Non-Empty Aerosol Cans
- Paint & Solvents

HHW must be taken to a County-operated collection center. The nearest centers are located at the Prima Deshecha Landfill and in the City of Irvine. Business waste is not accepted.

GLASS

- Food Bottles
- Beverage Bottles
- Liquor Bottles
- Soda Bottles
- Juice Bottles
- Wine Bottles
- Jars



METAL

- Empty Aerosol Cans
- Aluminum Cans
- Tin Cans
- Food/Juice Cans
- Empty Paint Cans (dry paint is O.K.)
- Aluminum Foil



PLASTICS

- Clothes Hangers
- Drink Bottles
- Plastic Toys
- Detergent Containers
- Water Bottles
- Milk Containers
- Most Plastics Labeled



PAPER

- Cardboard
- Junk Mail
- Magazines
- Phonebooks
- Cereal/Cracker Boxes
- Newspaper
- Computer Paper
- White & Colored Paper
- Pizza Boxes (no cheese)

TEXTILES

- Clothing
- Shoes
- Linens
- Towels
- Please place in clear plastic shopping bag and place in CR&R Recycling bins

NOTE:

- Grocery and Dry Cleaning Bags must be bundled into 1 non-black plastic bag and tied



TRASH

- Food Scraps
- Mixed Products (i.e. Plastic/metal combination)
- Waxed Milk Cartons
- Waxed Paper
- Ceramic/Pyrex
- Mirrors
- Safety Glass
- Plate Glass
- Pet Waste
- Palm Branches
- Diseased Plants
- Meat/Fish/Bones
- Metal Coat Hangers
- Dairy Products
- Pails
- Flower/Plant Containers
- Plant Holders
- Plastic Plates
- Food Trays
- Clothes Hampers
- Tupperware Containers
- Paper Towels
- Tissue Paper
- Styrofoam
- Diapers



Please note that CR&R offers white recycling bins at a discounted rate, however, to maximize recycling efforts all multi-family blue trash bins are sent to a material recovery facility.
