

## Real Estate & Open House Sign Standards

Real Estate and Open House signs that do not conform to the following standards are in violation of the Laguna Hills Municipal Code specified in section 9-42.200 F & G.

## Real Estate Signs

- Text on the sign shall be limited to information relating to the sale, lease or rental of the premises in which the sign is located.
- A maximum of one sign per building site is permitted and is restricted to the front yard of the property for sale.
- Sign size is limited to six (6) square feet and six (6) feet in height.
- Signs shall be removed upon the close of escrow or when lease or rental has been accomplished.

## **Open House Signs**

- Entrance signs (signs posted at tract entrances off all major arterials) shall be any combination of green and white or a Homeowners' Association sign previously approved by the Community Development Director.
- Each sign shall be firmly affixed to a support stake and shall not exceed a height of four (4) feet, and an area of four (4) square feet.
- Signs shall bear the copy "OPEN HOUSE" with an arrow pointing in the appropriate direction.
- Only two signs per site.
- Only one sign shall be placed at the entrance to each tract.
- Only one sign per each change of direction at intersection within the tract.
- Open house signs may be located in the public right-of-way, but shall not be attached to fire hydrants, traffic signals, or utility poles, nor placed in any area that may interfere with vehicular or pedestrian traffic.
- No sign shall be placed on private property without the consent of the owner.
- Signs may only be displayed during open house hours and shall not exceed the period between dawn and dusk daily.
