Donation rules per City Tree Preservation Policy No. 315

1. Only 15-gallon trees, 1-gallon plants or 5-gallon plants will be planted.
2. The donating individual may request the location of the tree planting/landscape planting but the City shall select the final planting location.
3. The donating individual may request a particular tree species/landscape material for planting but the City shall select/approve the tree species/landscape materials which best fits the area, City maintenance obligations and availability of irrigation systems.
4. The tree planting/landscape planting will occur during normal business hours or during special events and the donating individual will be invited to attend the planting.
5. The City shall maintain the landscaping.
6. A letter of acknowledgement of the donation shall be issued to the donating individual.
7. No marker or plaque shall be installed at any tree donation location.
